- **FY26 ROSC Projects – Landriah reviewed.**
  - Increase the accessibility and availability of recovery supports within Shelby County, ensuring that individuals in need are aware of, and able to access recovery resources and services.

  - Establish DOPP Sites in the most rural communities of Shelby County for distribution of harm reduction materials.

  - Assist in establishment of a Safe Passage in Shelby County to assist those seeking support and transportation to treatment.

Youth Prevention was brought up by Heather Lindahl.
